Perhaps this month the Holy Spirit will awaken you with these words, "Beware the Ides of March."

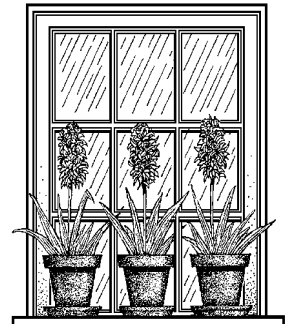
